We are inviting people to express an interest in this position which is shortly becoming available. We are an active Assemblies of God Church with an attached Anna Chaplaincy, and International Evangelical Church. The church is located near the town-centre and set within an established community with a variety of social need.

We are a welcoming community of Christians who are practiced in offering support to each other, and passionate about the church growing in its spirituality. Our priority is to identify the person God has prepared and anointed to lead us forward. The person will have a heart for nurturing, developing, and promoting the expression of gifts – both spiritual and natural – for the ministry of the local church in our town.

Ideally the person appointed would have proven ability in church leadership, motivational and inspirational preaching of the scriptures. A willingness to connect with other church leaders in the region / town is essential. As is, a heart and passion for reaching out into the local community. We endorse the commission of the Church to make disciples and to facilitate them in discovering, developing their spiritual gifts and then being deployed in the work of the ministry. The gifts of Holy Spirit are regularly exercised in our meetings, and we expect that the person appointed would be able to promote this aspect of the life of the fellowship.

We would prefer the person appointed to be a person in 'good standing' with Assemblies of God in the UK, and ideally one who has had ministerial responsibility in a local church. Alternatively, a Minister in Training, or a person willing to undertake that training would be considered.

Initially, we envision the post will be for 20 hours per week, worked flexibly in agreement with the church oversight. This will be reviewed on an annual basis.
